Action Items In-Progress / Pending:

1. We have now used our SST timing systems at 3 swim meets, all with SAMMS as the computer operating system. We are still learning and SST seems willing to make changes that would help. The features of automatically printing results and automatically advancing the events and heats is a big relief to the timing operator. We need to get experience using it with Hy-Tek.

Questions for the Board / Larger Group:

1. We need Pacific to automate and put online several labor intensive processes. This includes registration and payment, checking for registered swimmers at entry time, and getting and verifying swimmers' current entry times. This would dramatically reduce all the paperwork in handling registration forms and check payments by Pacific. It would eliminate the need for registration checks done by Pacific, and it would significantly reduce related work for clubs and zones hosting meets.
