SANCTION: Held under USA/Pacific Swimming Sanction No. 14-013

In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

NOTICE: By entering this meet, the athlete or his/her guardian consents to the publication, via electronic, print or other media, information and/or imagery related to their participation at this meet. Such information and imagery may include, but is not limited to, photographs, video, web casting, television, psych sheets and live meet results. **The results of this meet may be posted in real time on the Internet.**

USE OF AUDIO AND VISUAL: Photography and video recording from behind the blocks or starting areas is prohibited unless prior permission is granted by the Meet Referee. Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

LOCATION: Gilroy High School, 750 W. Tenth Street, Gilroy, CA 95020. From 101, take the Tenth Street exit in Gilroy. Follow Tenth St. and make a left on Princevalle Ave. Pool entrance is on the right hand side.

COURSE: Outdoor heated 25 yard course with up to 6 competition lanes available. The minimum water depth at the shallow end of this pool measures 6 feet, with a maximum depth of 12 feet, and is in accordance with article 103.2.3. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with USA Swimming Article 104.2.2C(4). Separate warm-up /warm-down pool will be available.

TIME: Meet will begin at 9 AM each day with warm-ups from 7:30 to 8:45 AM each day. A special warm-up time for 8 and under swimmers only will be held from 8:30-8:45 AM in designated lanes.

- **RULES:** Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.
 - All events are timed finals and will be swum slow to fast.
 - Swimmers may compete in **3 individual** events per day.
 - All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner.

UNACCOMPANIED SWIMMERS: Any USA-S athlete-member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming member-coach for the purposes of athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a coach-member of the athlete's USA-S Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA-S member-coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the athlete's USA-S Club Member-Coach.

RACING STARTS: Swimmers must be certified by a USA-S member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start, or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RESTRICTIONS: • Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator

- seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers, during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue.
- No propane heater is permitted except for snack bar/meet operations.
- All shelters must be properly secured.

• Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is strongly discouraged

ELIGIBILITY: • Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host will check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail.

• Swimmers must be current members of a "Zone 1 South Division 1 team". Unattached swimmers may compete but not score points for their new team or swim relays.

• Swimmers in the "A" Division must have met at least the listed "PC-A" time standard. Swimmers in the "B" Division must have met at least the listed "PC-B" time standard. All entry times slower than the listed "PC-B" time standard will be in the "C" Division.

• Entries with "NO TIME" will be accepted.

• Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.

- Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding and special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.
- Swimmers 19 years of age and over may compete in the meet for time only, no points or awards.
- The swimmer's age will be the age of the swimmer on the first day of the meet.

ENTRY FEES: \$2.75 per event plus an \$8.00 participation fee per swimmer. \$9.00 per Relay Team entered. Entries will be rejected if payment is not sent at time of request.

ONLINE ENTRIES: To enter online go to **http://ome.swimconnection.com/pc/zone1S20140111** to receive an immediate entry confirmation. This method requires payment by credit card. Swim Connection LLC charges a processing fee for this service, equal to \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total Entry Fees. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted through Thursday, January 2.

MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES: Entries must be on the attached consolidated entry form. Forms must be filled out completely and printed clearly with swimmers best time. Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday, December 30 or hand delivered by 6:30 p.m. Thursday, January 2. No late entries will be accepted. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs. Requests for confirmation of receipt of entries should include a self-addressed envelope.

RELAY ENTRIES: Each Zone 1 South team is limited to one relay team in each relay event. Relays will be entered by each teams' coaches (must be mailed or hand delivered by the deadlines below). **No deck entered relay teams will be allowed. A swimmer who is unattached is ineligible to participate in a relay.** Relays must be entered with the enclosed relay entry form containing the event number and entry time for each relay team entered, written in the appropriate areas. Do not list the swimmer's names on the Relay Entry Form. Swimmers not in the meet, but wishing to participate in relays must be listed on the Relay Only Entry Form; no fee is required for these swimmers. All Relay Entries, Relay Only Form, and payment must be mailed to the address below by Monday, December 30 or hand delivered by 6:30pm, Thursday, January 2, 2014.

- Relay entry cards will be generated by the computer operator and distributed to each team on the first day of the meet.
- Relay scratches must be turned into the Clerk of Course by 12:00 p.m. each day.
- Seeded relay cards for the day's relay events will be available at the Clerk of Course at 1:00 p.m. each day.
- NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE.

CHECK-IN: The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all individual events shall be no more than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. No event shall be closed more

than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session. Swimmers who do not check in will not be seeded and will not be allowed to compete in that event.

SCRATCHES: Swimmers entered in an individual event that they have checked in for, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before seeding for that event has begun. Swimmers who miss an event they have checked in for will not be penalized by the loss of the next event they have entered.

AWARDS: The swimmer's awards will be available to a team representative at the end of the competition each day. "A" medals will be awarded to swimmers achieving new "A" times. The team awards will be presented following the meet conclusion.
